

§ 1 Information about the collection of personal data and provider identification

- (1) The following provides information on the collection of personal data when using this website. Personal data means all the data that refers to you personally, e.g. name, address, e-mail addresses, user behavior.
- (2) The person responsible (data controller) pursuant to Art. 4 para. 7 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is Schwarze-Robitec GmbH, Olpener Str. 460-474 in 51109 Cologne, sales@schwarze-robitec.com (see our imprint). Our Data Protection Officer is Mr Andreas Pinheiro LL.M., a.pinheiro@ap-datenschutz.de.
- (3) If we intend to use contracted service providers for individual functions of our offering or would like to use your data for advertising purposes, we will inform you in detail about the respective processes as follows. We also specify the defined criteria for the retention period of your data.

§ 2 Rights, in particular to information and revocation

- (1) You have the following rights with regard to your personal data:
 - Right to information,
 - Right to rectification or deletion,
 - Right to restriction of processing,
 - Right to object to the processing,
 - Right to data portability.
- (2) If you have given us consent to use your data, you may withdraw this consent at any time. Should the lawfulness of the processing be based on consent, this consent shall remain valid until you withdraw your consent.
- (3) All requests for information, inquiries or objections to data processing should be sent by e-mail to sales@schwarze-robitec.com or to the address given under § 1 para. 2.
- (4) You may ask us to delete your data at any time. In this case, there may be legal retention periods, which allow us to retain your data until the expiry of the period.
- (5) If your data is incorrect, you have the right to ask us to rectify it. This request will be complied with immediately.
- (6) You have the right to receive from us your personal data provided to us in a readable format, as far as technically possible, in order to make it available to another company (right to data portability).
- (7) You have the right to submit a complaint to the supervisory authority competent for you.

§ 3 Data security

- (1) We maintain up to date technical measures to ensure data security, in particular to protect your personal data from the dangers of data transmission and from third parties gaining knowledge thereof. These will be adapted to the current state of the art.

§ 4 Collection of personal data in informational use and for contact purposes

- (1) If you only use the website for information purposes, i.e. if you do not register or otherwise provide us with information, we only collect the personal data that your browser transmits to our server. If you wish to view our website, we collect the following data, which is technically necessary for us to display our website to you and to guarantee its stability and security (legal basis: Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 letter f GDPR):
 - IP address
 - Date and time of access
 - Difference in time zones based on Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)
 - Content of the request (specific page)
 - Access status/HTTP status code
 - Data volumes transmitted
 - Website from which the request originates
 - Browser
 - Operating system and its interface
 - Language and version of the browser software
- (2) The legal basis for the indicated collection is the consent that you have given by visiting our website and clicking on the cookie banner (Art. 6 para. 1 letter a GDPR).
- (3) We will only use your data for advertising purposes to the extent permitted by law. In particular, we will only use your e-mail address for the direct advertising of our own similar goods or services. You can object to the use of your data for advertising purposes at any time in writing or in text form (e-mail to sales@schwarze-robitec.com). Here we refer to our legitimate interest in advertising our products to our customers pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 letter f GDPR.
- (4) In addition to the aforementioned data, cookies are stored on your computer when you use our website. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your hard drive assigned to your browser and through which certain information flows to the location that places the cookie (in this case, by us). Cookies cannot execute programs or transmit viruses to your computer. Their purpose is to make the Internet offering more user-friendly and effective overall.

§ 5 Cookies

- (1) We use cookies on our website. These cookies are necessary so that you can move freely around the website and use its features, including access to secure areas of the website. Cookies allow us to track who has visited the page(s), and from this we can deduce how often certain pages are visited and therefore which parts of the website are particularly popular. Session cookies store information about your activities on our website.
- (2) This website uses the following types of cookies, the scope and functionality of which are explained below:
 - Transient cookies (temporary use)
 - Persistent cookies (time-limited use)
 - Third-party cookies
- (3) Transient cookies are automatically deleted when you close your browser. These include session cookies in particular. They store a so-called session ID, which can be used to assign various requests from your browser to the shared session. This allows your computer to be recognized when you return to our website. Session cookies are deleted when you log out or close your browser.
- (4) Persistent cookies are automatically deleted after a specified period, which may vary depending on the cookie. You can delete the cookies at any time in the security settings of your browser.
- (5) You can configure your browser settings as you wish and, for example, refuse the acceptance of third-party cookies or all cookies. However, please note that you may not be able to use all the functions of the website in this case.
- (6) We use cookies to allow us to identify you for future visits if you have an account with us. Otherwise you would have to log in again for each visit.

§ 6 Data transmission for website maintenance

- (1) We will not pass on your personal data to third parties before we inform you of such a transmission.
- (2) Our IT service providers have access to our stored data in order to correct errors and enable us to carry out the required technical and organizational measures. In this regard, we refer to our legitimate interest in securing our IT pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 letter f GDPR and to the fulfillment of legal obligations pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 letter c GDPR.
- (3) The IT service provider(s) were carefully selected and contracted by us in writing. They are obliged to follow our instructions and are regularly monitored by us. The service providers will not pass this data on to third parties.
- (4) Your data is forwarded to the newsletter provider Rapidmail via our newsletter. Further information on the processing can be found in section 8.
- (5) Your data will not be forwarded outside the EU (EEA) area.

§ 7 Use of our portal

- (1) If you wish to use our portal, you must register by entering your e-mail address, a self-chosen password and your freely selectable user name. There is no obligation to use a proper name, you may use a pseudonym. For registration, we use the so-called double opt-in procedure, i.e. your registration is not completed until you have confirmed your registration by clicking on the link contained in a confirmation e-mail sent to you for this purpose. If your confirmation is not received within 24 hours, your registration will be automatically deleted from our database. The provision of the aforementioned data is mandatory, you can provide any further information voluntarily by using our portal.
- (2) If you use our portal, we will store your data necessary for the performance of the contract, including details of the method of payment, until you finally delete your access. Furthermore, we store the data voluntarily provided by you for the duration of your use of the portal, unless you delete it beforehand. You can manage and change all your information in the protected customer area. The legal basis is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 letter f GDPR.
- (3) In order to prevent unauthorized access by third parties to your personal data, in particular financial data, the connection is encrypted using TLS technology.

§ 8 Newsletter

- (1) With your consent, you can subscribe to our newsletter, which we use to inform you about our latest interesting offers. The advertised goods and services are stated in the declaration of consent. When registering for a user account you can decide to subscribe to the Schwarze-Robitec newsletter. To do this, check the box next to "Subscribe to newsletter".
- (2) We use the so-called double opt-in procedure for our newsletter subscriptions. This means that after your registration we will send you an e-mail to the e-mail address you provided to us in which we will ask you to confirm that you wish to receive the newsletter. If you do not confirm your registration within 24 hours, your information will be blocked and automatically deleted after one month. In addition, we store the IP addresses you use and the dates of registration and confirmation. The purpose of this procedure is to prove your registration and, if necessary, to clarify any possible misuse of your personal data.
- (3) Your e-mail address is the only mandatory information we need for you to receive our newsletter. After your confirmation, we will save your e-mail address for the purpose of sending you the newsletter. The legal basis is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 letter a GDPR.
- (4) You can withdraw your consent to receive the newsletter at any time and unsubscribe from the newsletter. You can notify us of the withdrawal of your consent by clicking on the link provided in every newsletter e-mail, by sending an e-mail to sales@schwarze-robitec.com or by sending a message to the contact details given in the imprint.
- (5) You can withdraw your consent to receive the newsletter at any time and unsubscribe from the newsletter. - (6) We would like to mention that we evaluate your user behavior when sending the newsletter. For this evaluation, the e-mails sent contain so-called web beacons, also known as tracking pixels. These are one-pixel image files that link to our website and thus enable us to evaluate your user behavior. This is done by collecting the data mentioned in section 4 as well as web beacons, which are assigned to your e-mail address and linked to your own ID. Links received in the newsletter also contain this ID. We use the data obtained in this way to create a user profile so that we can provide you with the newsletter tailored to your interests. As part of this process, we record when you read our newsletters, which links you click in them and infer your personal interests from this. We link this data with the actions you take on our website. The information collected in this way is stored by the newsletter provider RapidMail on its server in Germany.
- (7) You can object to this tracking at any time by clicking on the separate link provided for this purpose in each e-mail or by informing us at sales@schwarze-robitec.com.

§ 9 Web tracking - Google Analytics

- (1) This website uses Google Analytics, a web analysis service of Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses so-called "cookies", which are text files stored on your computer enabling an analysis of your use of the website (see section 5). The information generated by the cookie about your use of this website is usually transferred to a Google server in the USA and stored there. If IP anonymization is activated on this website, your IP address will be truncated by Google prior to transmission in member states of the European Union or in other countries which are parties to the Agreement on the European Economic Area. The full IP address will be transmitted to a Google server in the USA and truncated there only in exceptional cases. § 10 Use of eTracker

- (1) (1) This website uses etracker GmbH (<http://www.etracker.com>) technology to collect and store data for marketing and optimization purposes. This data can be used to create user profiles under a pseudonym. Cookies may be used for this purpose. Cookies are small text files that are stored locally in the cache of the Internet browser of the website visitor. These cookies enable the Internet browser to be recognized. The data collected with the eTracker technologies will not be used to personally identify visitors to this website and will not be merged with personal data about the bearer of the pseudonym without the specific consent of the person concerned. The consent for the data collection and storage may be withdrawn at any time with effect for the future.

§ 11 Use of social media plug-ins

- (1) We currently use the following social media plug-ins: Google+. We use the so-called two-click solution. This means that when you visit our website, no personal data is initially passed on to the providers of the plug-ins. You can recognize the provider of the plug-in by the mark on the box above their initial letter or the logo. We offer you the possibility of communicating directly with the provider of the plug-in via the button. Only if you click on the marked field and thereby activate it will the plug-in provider receive the information that you have accessed the corresponding website of our online offering. In addition, the data mentioned under section 2 of this declaration will be transmitted. In the case of Facebook and Xing, the IP address is anonymized immediately after collection according to information provided by the respective providers in Germany. By activating the plug-in, your personal data is transferred to the respective plug-in provider and stored there (in the case of US providers in the USA). As the plug-in provider collects data in particular via cookies, we recommend that you delete all cookies via your browser's security settings before clicking on the grayed-out box.
- (2) We have no control over the collected data and data processing operations, nor are we aware of the full extent of data collection, the purposes of processing, and the storage periods. We also do not have any information on the deletion of the data collected by the plug-in provider.
- (3) The plug-in provider stores the data collected about you as user profiles and uses these for the purposes of advertising, market research and/or the appropriate design of its website. Such an evaluation is carried out in particular (also for users who are not logged in) in order to display appropriate advertising and to inform other users of the social network about your activities on our website. You have the right to object to the creation of these user profiles; to exercise this right, please contact the respective plug-in provider. The plug-ins give you the opportunity of interacting with social networks and other users so that we can improve our offering and make it more interesting for you as a user. We recommend that you log out regularly after using a social network, especially before activating the button, as this allows you to avoid such an assignment to your profile by the plug-in provider.
